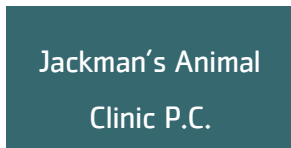

- Lake Santee Beach Front Grill and the Kiwanis Club will provide fruit, and other snacks at Lake Santee sag stop. Four sag stops on 62 route.
- 62 mile ride is a very hilly, scenic route which travels through many sites, including a covered bridge, Jawacdah Farms, Hillendbrand Airport, Lake Santee, and 5 churches.
- 30 mile ride travels to Lake Santee, around and back. Mostly flat with some hills.
- 13 mile ride is a nice country ride. Mostly flat with some hills.
